



NEW TRUCK-MOUNTED CONCRETE PUMPS

Schwing-Stetter is presenting new product developments in all fields of concrete production and handling technology: concrete mixing plants, truck mixers and concrete pumps as well as placing booms.

Among others, Schwing-Stetter will present two new truck-mounted concrete pumps – one in the 20 m class, and another in the 40 m full-size boom class. There will also be innovations in the new stationary concrete pumps.

A new separate placing boom and a new mixing plant will also be presented, rounding off the range of products. Schwing-Stetter will exhibit its range of products at the Bauma 2010 on a surface of 2.120 m².

HIGH-PERFORMANCE CRANE MODELS

A whole series of experienced and tested solutions will be added to the extensive product range shown on the Palfinger stand: truck-mounted cranes with interesting equipment options for the construction industry, new PC cranes, Epsolution recycling cranes (including the new patent pending Easy-Fold system), PAK 13 H skiploader, a selection of transportable forklifts by Crayler and a MBB tail lift.

The Italian MB S.p.A shows its line of crushing buckets, indicated mainly for demolition, excavation, restoration, material recycling and construction in general. The models are used as an implement of hydraulic excavators which cover the range of 8 to 28 ton.

The latest crushing bucket is the BF 90.3. This model, which has a capacity of 0.75 cu.mt, weighs 3,500 kg, is suitable for machines from 20 to 28 tons of operating weight and produces a material with particle size between 60 and 80 mm.
