



EMITEC converts emissions

Emissions technology company Emitec has developed a highly efficient, compact diesel oxidation catalyst (DOC) for small engines.

Called the Compact Cat, Emitec said it developed the catalyst for use on engines in the 37-56kW power sector to meet Stage IIIB emissions regulations, without needing additional space for installation.

Cleverly, the Compact Cat makes full use of available exhaust gas temperatures by routing the gas back over the

outside of the catalyst after the initial flow-through process. This speeds up the catalyst warming process to improve emission cleaning ability on machines such as rollers, where short duty cycles often mean engines can rapidly cool down between re-use.

Emitec said its robust metal catalyst can be installed directly at the exhaust manifold or turbocharger outlet, as a result of it being resistant to high exhaust temperatures, pulsation and vibration.

YANMAR LAUNCHES SMALL ENGINES

Yanmar Europe has introduced two new 4TNV compact engines that meet Tier 4i/Stage IIIB emissions requirements while giving greater output.
