Want to see a live demonstration of a "green" technology used for crushing and recycling materials for reuse as gravel or natural fill?

Birmingham-based Thompson Tractor will soon debut MB America's Crusher Bucket to the public in Spanish Fort, Huntsville and Birmingham. The machinery, which reduces waste and material in landfills, is used for construction and excavation, road work, quarries, mines and environmental reclamation projects.

All public demonstrations will run from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
